The write-ups should be done on **single side** of each page.

Following are the parameters of assessment - content, creativity, presentation, accuracy and organization of the thoughts:

TOPIC	DESCRIPTION
1.Short story (2 pages)	Write a short story (200-250 words) based on the theme 'Honesty is the best policy' or 'Where there is a will there is a way'.
2. Comic Strip (1 page)	An illustration of your favourite cartoon character. (minimum 6 frames and maximum 10 frames)
3. Poster Making (1 page)	Make a poster with a message that you would like to spread in your society. (for example Save Girl child, Save Trees, Child labour etc.)
4. Paragraph (2 pages)	https://sites.google.com/dpshyderabad.com/primarylibrary/home?authuser=0 Using the link above read the stories and write a paragraph (80-100) about your favourite character.
5. Miscellaneous page (1 page)	A creative assortment of favourite recipe/ idioms/ jokes/ anecdotes/ scientific/ your own poem/ quizzes/ current affairs.

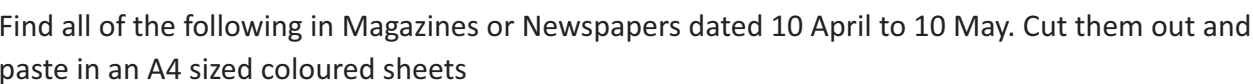
