INDIA IN 2047: THE GLOBAL POWERHOUSE

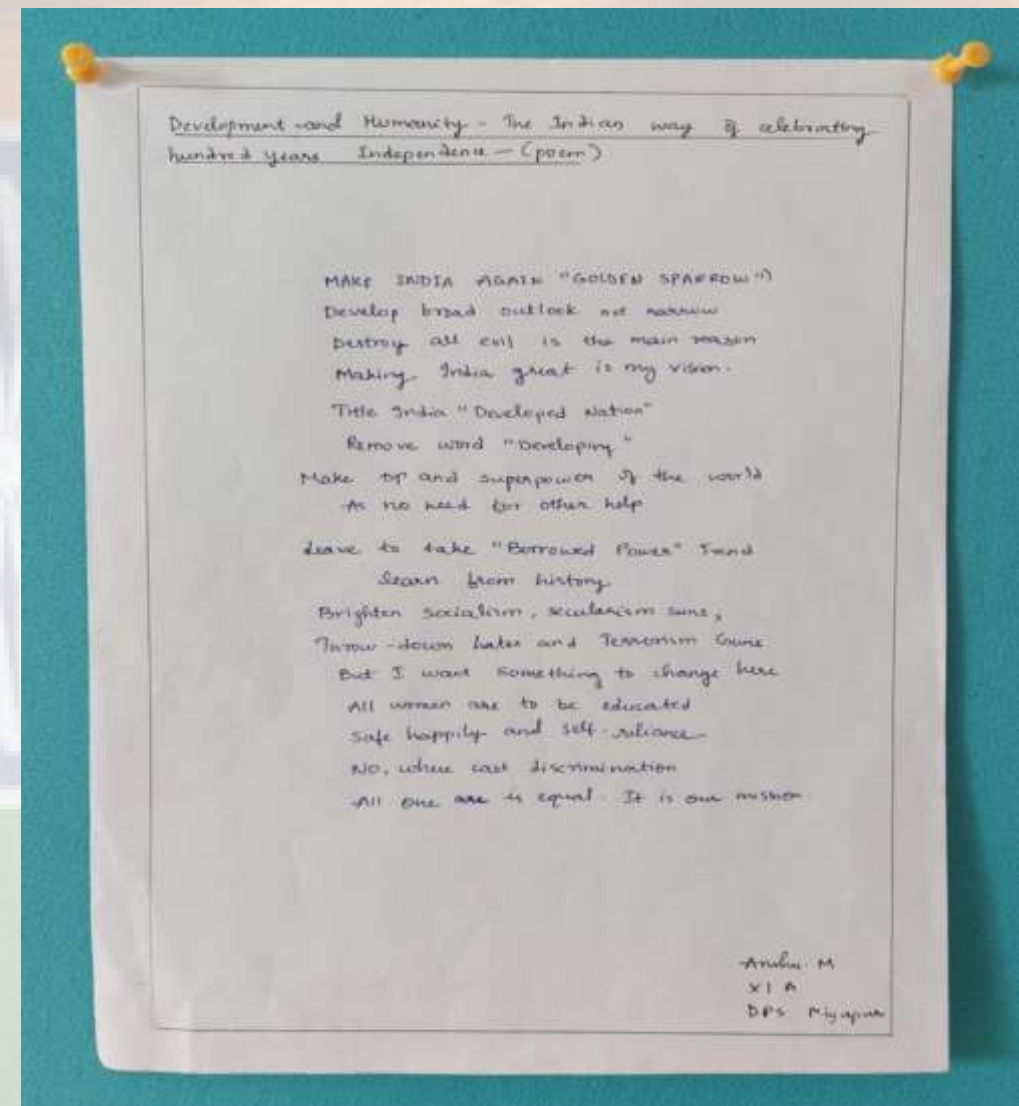
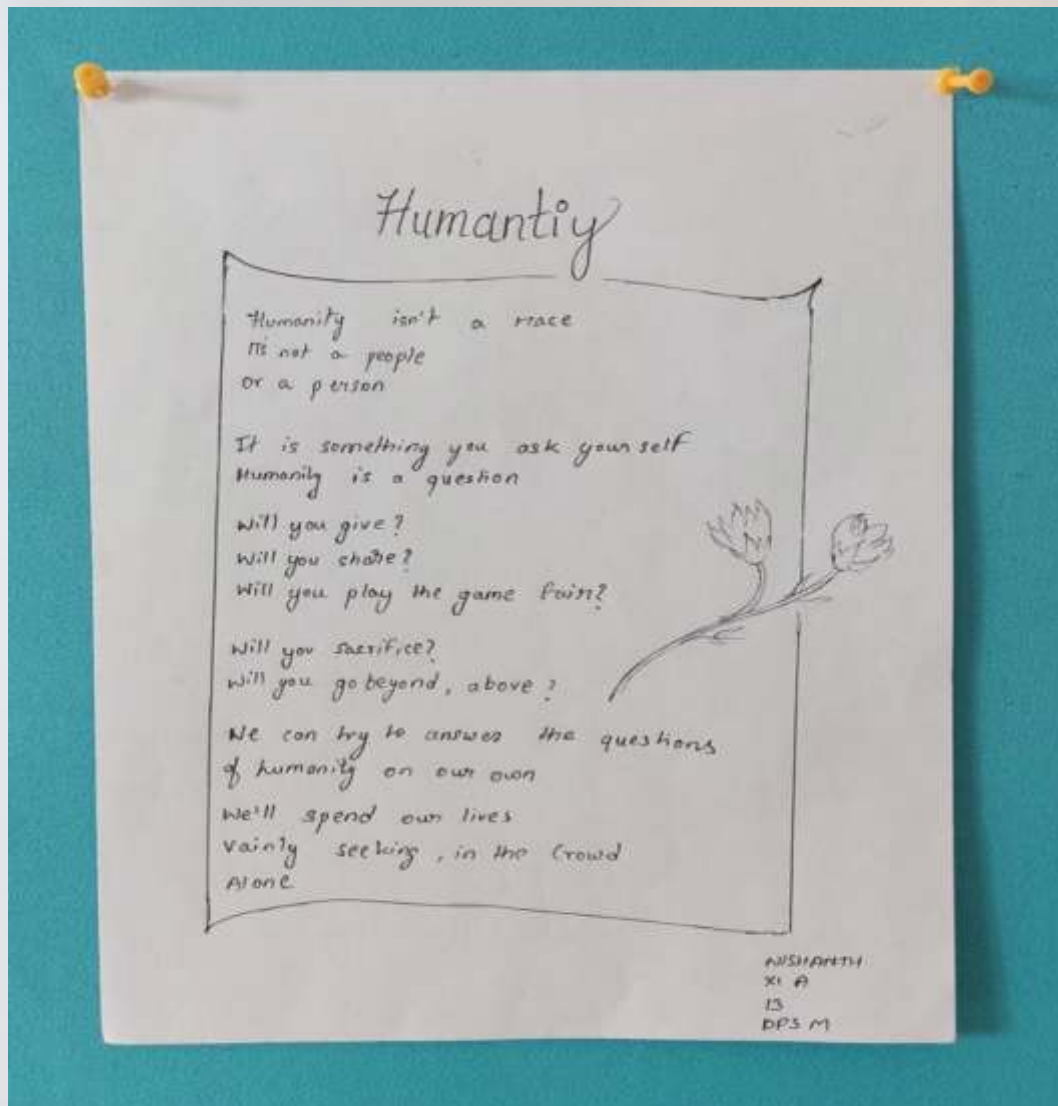
