Ancient Pens

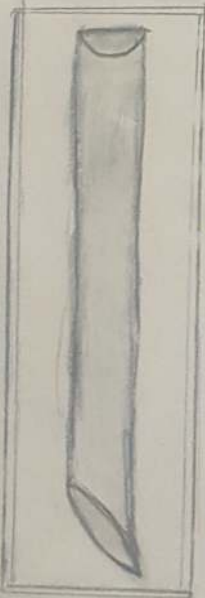
Humans started writing about 5,500 years ago using symbols and characters. As the writing language developed, so did the writing tools.

BOOK REVIEW – PERCY JACKSON

Percy Jackson and the lightning thief is a fantasy fiction based on Greek mythology. It is the first book in the series Percy Jackson and the Olympians. This book is about a 12-year-old boy, Percy Jackson who accidentally vaporizes his maths teacher on a field trip. After getting expelled for the 6th consecutive year he reaches camp half-blood which is a summer camp for demigods like him. Soon after reaching the camp Poseidon god of the sea claims Percy as his son. The following day Percy finds out Zeus's Lightning bolt gets stolen in the winter solstice and Percy is the Prime suspect. To get rid of this accusation Percy and his friends Grover and Annabeth travel throughout America to find the real lightning thief. The three main characters of this book are Percy Jackson, Annabeth, and Grover. There are also some minor characters like Luke Castellan, Medusa, Chiron-Percy's instructor, Ares, and Dionysus the camp director. My favorite character in this book is Annabeth, daughter of Athena. She is a very wise and strategic girl. The setting of the story gradually changes from New York to Los Angeles. I enjoyed reading this book because it is very humorous and filled with a lot of suspense. My favorite part of the book was the few last chapters because they finally revealed the thrilling twist. The author uses many storytelling devices like metaphors, alliteration, and similes which engage young readers. I will recommend this book to anyone who is into Greek mythology who is in the age group 12-14. I give this book 4.5/5.



The Kolkata Test - 2021

PRAKHAR MISHRA (VII - C)

This is the story of the greatest test match ever played. This is the story of how Indian cricket made its comeback from bad form and showed Australia that they are the champs, let's start the story. It begins just before the test. Australia was riding on 15 consecutive test victories. So, the Aussie skipper Steve Waugh declared India as the final frontier and publicly declared that "The next three tests would be 16, 17 and 18. Normally India would ignore those comments as mind games which was the norm, but this time things were different. This team was led by a young and fearless Sourav Ganguly. He said that "Enjoy the rest and forget about 16, 17, and 18. Now it was time for the test. The Aussies completely outplayed India by defeating them badly in the first test. Now it was time for the second test.

Australia won the toss and decided to bat first. Riding on a century from Steve Waugh and brilliant innings from Matthew Hayden and Justin Langer and despite getting a big scare due to a hat-trick from the Indian spinner Harbhajan Singh Australia managed to put on a total of 445. Then the Indian innings started, which became a disaster. Except VVS Laxman who had got back pain no one was able to hit a half-century, they got all out on 171 due to which Australia imposed follow-on on them. After the innings when VVS Laxman was going into the dressing room the Australians around him told that it is boring to play against India and they should not give them a follow, they should just finish it fast and just rest. Now it was the time for the second innings. Shiv Sundar Das and Sadagopan Ramesh started well with a half-century stand. Then after some good partnerships and losing wickets, India reached 232 for 4, now it was time for the record-breaking 376 run partnership between Laxman and Dravid. They started playing with the mindset to save the test as they were under the pressure of following on. On one hand, Dravid hit 180 and Laxman hit 281, they played for 2 days, they saved the test.

At the end of the Indian innings, India scored a whopping total of 657 for 7 while getting a good lead of 384 which was a good total for Australia to chase which they could not, and lost by 171 runs. So, India after being under pressure due to the follow-on. After losing badly in the first test, after facing a lot of criticism India won the second and third tests to mark the revival of Indian test Cricket.

In the second test, Harbhajan Singh showed top bowling performance by taking 7 for 123 in the first innings and 6 for 73 in the second innings respectively. VVS Laxman was awarded as the man of the match in the second test for 59 in the first innings and 281 in the second respectively.
